Dear guest

Welcome to the Old Gatehouse! We hope you had a good journey and are starting to settle in. We want you to treat The Old Gatehouse like your home for however long you are staying, and we are on hand if you have any questions or need any help during your stay.

The Old Gatehouse sits in Pembroke a historic medieval town in the heart of Pembrokeshire, close to many unspoilt beaches and the beautiful Pembrokeshire coast yet only a short distance away from local amenities, shops and restaurants.

The cottage likely dates to the 16th century and is linked to Underdown Country House parts of which date back to the Siege of Pembroke Castle where Oliver Cromwell's troops were encamped there. It was also the home of Admiral Tyler the White. Admiral Sir Charles Tyler (1760 - 28 September 1835) was a naval officer in the British Royal Navy who gained fame during the Napoleonic Wars and the Battle of Trafalgar, becoming one of the Nelsonic Band of Brothers. He was also responsible for introducing maritime training for sea men.


Access arrangements

Parking

Parking is available for one car immediately outside the front gate. You can also park on the road next to the property.

If preferred to keep additional vehicles off the road you are very welcome to park on our grounds at Underdown Country House (along the private ¼ mile private drive). You are also very welcome to drive up and turn the car at Underdown which has plenty of room for turning. Additionally, if you park very close to the stone wall at the bottom of Underdown drive/side of the cottage (option 2a or 2b) your car will be off the public road. As this is our private drive it is very quiet.



We just need adequate space to pass your car.

If you need help with anything during your stay, please do not hesitate to call or text myself or John. If there are any problems with the accommodation during your stay, please report this to us immediately so we can rectify them as soon as possible.

Safety

Please take care when entering and exiting the building, especially with children as it sits alongside a road.

Fire

The Cottage has been completely renovated with care given to maintaining original features such as the double inglenook fireplace. A feature stove is present with electrical flame effect but for safety reasons it is not in use as a log fire. Please do not light matches or attempt to make a fire within the building. We have very recently finished refurbishing the cottage including new plumbing and wiring.

A fire extinguisher can be found in the Kitchen cupboard (next to the cooker) and a large water fire extinguisher in the Inglenook Fireplace. A fire blanket is also included in the kitchen (mounted on the kitchen unit next to the sink). A large water mist fire extinguisher (suitable for any type of fire) is situated at the top of the stairs.

Smoke and Carbon monoxide detectors are fitted throughout the house. The kitchen heat sensor is particularly loud and sensitive. If the alarm goes off due to cooking smoke press the button on the alarm to stop it. If there is a fire out of control, please call 999 and leave the property by the front or back door.

The garden is terraced with some unfenced areas that can be hazardous for young children due to falling or tripping. Careful supervision of young children is essential whilst using the garden. The picket fence gate should be used when young children have access to the patio and very close supervision on the grass area.

Shops and Supplies

We have numerous large supermarkets/shops in Pembroke Dock (Aldi. Lidl, Tesco, ASDA, Wilko, B&M, Peacocks, Argos- located 2 miles from Pembroke. We also have a Co-op convenience store which has a good supply of provisions. Open 6am until 11 pm

Household Maintenance

Water

If there is a major leak turn off the water supply as soon as possible at the following stopcocks: airing cupboard outside the upstairs bathroom – hot and cold supply lever valves, which are labelled; if there is still water escape, the main stopcock is in the wall opposite the downstairs WC behind a plastic access panel. Once the water has been stopped please call John or myself for assistance.

If there are any problems with the electrics or one or the electrical appliances during your stay, please let us know as soon as possible so we can try to fix it for you.

Fuse Box

The fuse box is in the wall cupboard in the living/ dining room adjacent to the door. If the lights/ electrics fail, please check the fuse box to see if one of the switches is down and push it to an upright position again. A torch is in the cupboard as well as by the front door and airing cupboard.

Heating and Hot Water

The Old Gatehouse has a mains pressure hot water cylinder, which is set for continuous hot water.

The heating is set to operate between 7am and 10pm, with the overall temperature controlled by the main thermostat on the dining room wall. Each

radiator also has its own thermostat for individual room control. If you would like to change the operating times, the controller is in the airing cupboard outside the upstairs bathroom.

Please do not use the immersion heater, which is intended for boiler breakdowns only.

At the end of your stay, please set the main thermostat in the dining room to 15°C.

Lounge/Diner

TV/DVD

We understand that many people have their own streaming subscriptions. We have therefore recently installed a new interactive TV operated by remote control and a Netflix account for the cottage (profile: @OldGateHouse). We also have a DVD player and a selection of sanitised DVDs will be left for your use. If you need a bigger selection just let us know and we will drop them off to you. We also have a television in the downstairs (king size) bedroom.

Can be turned on using the electrical socket in the base kitchen unit next to the cooker. The socket is labelled.

Detailed instruction scan be found in the instructions folder. We would advise setting a wash cycle and drying washing on the line or setting the dry cycle once the wash has finished. The automatic wash / dry cycle tends is more difficult to set and could result in your washing drying to hot with accompanying shrinkage of clothes.

Clean foot towel and mats have been provided for your stay.

Bedrooms

The cottage has two king-size bedrooms, a twin bedroom and a small single. All linen and towels are provided.

Shaver plugs

Shaver plugs are available and are in the drawer unit in the porch

Hair straighteners

Most of the bedrooms have a heat mat or holder to prevent burns to the furniture.

Velux Blinds

To open or close push handle at the bottom and raise up or own

Bluetooth Sound bar

Are available in the bedrooms for use with WIFI.

Instructions

Turn on the Bluetooth Soundbar using the on/Off volume control dial in a clockwise direction, until it clicks. Pause track by pressing >II; push it again to resume the track. Adjust the volumem0t the Mini Bluetooth Soundbar using the on/off/volume control dial. Rotate the on/off/Volume control in a clockwise direction. Decrease the volume by rotating in an anticlockwise direction. Cycle between functions by pressing **M** until the desired option is selected (Bluetooth, Aux, USB, TF. Rotate the on/off/Volume control dial in an anticlockwise direction, until it clicks to turn off the mini Bluetooth Soundbar.

Step 1

Once the Bluetooth Soundbar is turned on the LED indicator light will flash blue in quick bursts to indicate that that the mini Bluetooth soundbar is ready to be aired with a Bluetooth compatible device.

Step 2

Search for the mini Bluetooth Soundbar using a Bluetooth compatible device. Select EE172 and pair. Once a connection has been made, the LED indicator light will remain blue to indicate that the devices are paired.

Once connected, sound can be controlled using either the mini Bluetooth Soundbar or the relevant controls on the Bluetooth compatible device.

Extra Pillows

Additional pillows can be found in the downstairs bedroom cupboard.

Children

Bed guard, highchair, child toilet seat and **child step** will be left out on request. A child gate is available for the stairs. Additional child gates on request.

Nappies

A very special request to all guests with babies. Please dispose of nappies and wipes in the **nappy sack bags** provided and use the nappy bin. If you need to empty the nappy bin place in the household waste bag. (**The refuse needs to be carefully sorted with Pembrokeshire Council and we do not want to be handling dirty nappies**) Baby Wipes, wet wipes or face wipes will block the plumbing, and this is an old building

Smoking

The house is a strictly no smoking property. If you would like to smoke, please do so outside.

Shoes

We have provided a hallway basket for shoes. New carpets have recently been fitted upstairs and in the bedrooms. We would be grateful if you would remove your shoes when going upstairs. Due to the floor being tiled it would be more comfortable for you to bring along slippers.

Pets

We do not allow pets.

Garden

Take extreme care with very young children as the garden is terraced. Very young children should always be supervised.

Barbecue

A gas barbecue is available for guests to use. Please take care with children and leave as you find it. A cleaning spray/ degreaser "Deepio" that is safe for catering establishments has been provided in the outside garden container. A plastic rectangular container has also been provided to soak any metal items. Sprinkle Deepio into the water, leave for a few hours and the grease should fall away. Please don't wash barbecue items in the kitchen as it is quite difficult to remove the grease from surfaces etc. Please contact us if the gas runs empty and we will replace it for you.

Patio Furniture

Cushions for the garden furniture are stored in the large plastic storage box. Cushions should be stored here between use to keep them dry.

When leaving the property

(Please note- additional duties have been included to ensure compliance with Covid 19 requirements)

- Leave the property promptly on your day of departure at **9am** so that a full Covid 19 cleaning regime can be undertaken to protect the incoming guests.
- Place all crockery, cutlery and dishes in the dishwasher and set it for a high temperature wash.
- Ensure all rubbish is correctly sorted and place tied bags into the outside bins.
- Make sure all doors are locked and leave windows ajar.

Place the front door key onto the key hook next to the front door.

Rubbish

Waste in Pembrokeshire is now operating a very strict recycling policy for all waste and rubbish. This is a new requirement and household waste is now only collected every 3 weeks. We Incorrect recycling means the owners will need to sort through your rubbish putting them at risk therefore require you to separate all items for recycling. The additional risk of Covid 19 means that careful management of waste is essential.

Bins to separate waste have been provided in the kitchen area and can then be emptied into the larger dedicated bins have been provided in the garden area for food waste, glass, recycling and general waste. Card and Paper Separation

Food waste

Continue to use your food waste caddies and bags every week. Please do not put food packaging or liquids in your food caddy.

Please place all rubbish and recycling in the bins during your stay and when leaving. You do not need to move the bins for collection, this will be managed by the owners.


Accident and Emergency
